ARRIVING BY AIR:

[Denver International Airport](#) is 23 miles from the [Grand Hyatt Denver](#) and downtown. From the airport, you can take SuperShuttle, skyRide airport express bus, or a taxi or limousine to get to the downtown. Or you can rent a car. DIA is a new, user-friendly airport. There is a main terminal that handles check-in, baggage, security, etc., but all flights leave from one of three concourses. The concourses are served by an underground train; when you arrive, walk to the center of the concourse and take the escalator (or elevator) down to the train level. All ground transportation services at Denver International Airport are located in Jeppesen Terminal, level 5.

Wheelchair Transportation Services:

Wheelchair accessible transportation is available at Denver International Airport for disabled travelers. The Americans With Disabilities Act requires all ground transportation companies provide accessible vehicles. It is recommended that individuals needing this service make arrangements in advance with their chosen service provider.

The following door-to-door wheelchair transportation service providers pick up passengers at curbside on the West side of Jeppesen Terminal, Level 5.

- Mobility Plus 24-hour on-demand wheelchair accessible service (Yellow Cab): 303-777-7777
- Mobility Transport Service: 303-295-3900 (This company requires 24-hour advance notice)
- RTD access-a-Ride: 303-292-6560 (Accessible public transportation that requires an application and certification process. To apply for a access-a-Ride, please call 303-299-2960.)

SuperShuttle:

LSA has arranged for discounted shuttle service to/from DIA for \$32.00 round trip or \$19.00 one way per person. To receive the discount, make a reservation online at www.supershuttle.com. Enter UET2L as the discount code, or use the direct link:

Print confirmations or make note of confirmation numbers. You may call 1-800-BLUEVAN (800-258-3826) or 303-316-3865 for information or reservations, but you can only get the discounted rate online.

To get to the SuperShuttle vans when you arrive at the airport: Take the train from the concourse to the terminal. Pick up your luggage and report to the SuperShuttle Denver counter at DIA. Counter staff will issue tickets and give directions to the van loading area. Super Shuttle vans are blue with SUPERSHUTTLE printed on the side.

skyRide Denver Public Transportation (RTD) Bus and Light Rail:

The cheapest way (\$10) to get from the airport to downtown is via SkyRide. These are pleasant, clean express busses that connect downtown to DIA. On weekdays, the AF route bus leaves DIA approximately every half hour. On Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays, the bus leaves every hour (approximately 7 minutes after the top of the hour). To Take skyRide from DIA to Grand Hyatt

- From either East or West terminal, take bus AF (Cold Spring/Downtown/DIA)
- Get off at Market Street Station
- Take #MALL/Loop on SE of Market Street Station
- Get off 16th St. and Welton.
- Grand Hyatt is approximately 1.5 blocks East on Welton (1750 Welton).

To Take skyRide from Grand Hyatt to DIA (Reverse directions)

- Get on #0/0 Downtown either at Welton and 18th and Welton and 16th
- Exit Market Street Station (final stop)
- Take #AF to DIA, which will loop to both the East and West Terminals

Taxis:

Taxis can be found by walking outside DIA on level five; reservations when leaving from DIA are generally not necessary. All companies charge the same flat rate for travel from DIA to downtown: \$46.50 (plus gratuity, as of this writing). The rate from downtown to DIA is \$43.00 (plus gratuity, as of this writing).

Limousines:

Rates are rather comparable to taxis if traveling in a group. They must be reserved in advance. Below are three options.

Access Colorado Shuttle and Limousine: 720-338-5731 or www.accesscoloradoshuttle.com. DIA to downtown: 1-3 passengers in a Town Car, \$50; 6 passengers, \$75 (plus gratuity)

DIA Limousines: 303-292-3080 or www.dialimousines.com. DIA to downtown: 1-3 passengers, \$60; 4-6 passengers, \$85 (plus gratuity)

Denver Limo: 303-699-7788 or www.denvercoloradolimousine.com/denver-airport-limo.htm. DIA to downtown: 1-3 passengers, \$75; 6 passengers, \$85 (plus gratuity)

There are many other options that have similar pricing and can be found by Googling "DIA limo".

Rental Cars:

The airport has all major car rental agencies and plentiful cars. The cars themselves are located on lots remote from the terminal, about a 5-minute ride via the rental shuttles, on level five. The shuttles are frequent and the drivers courteous.

ARRIVING BY RAIL, BUS, or CAR:**Amtrak:**

Amtrak's California Zephyr route stops at Union Station, 1701 Wynkoop St., approximately 11 blocks from the Grand Hyatt Denver. See www.amtrak.com or call 800-872-7245 for schedule and fare information.

Bus:

The Greyhound Bus Station is at 2147 N. Broadway, approximately 6 blocks from the Grand Hyatt Denver. See www.greyhound.com or call 800-231-2222 for schedule and fare information.

Car:**Driving Directions to Grand Hyatt Denver in Downtown Denver:**

Consult googlemaps, mapquest, etc. for directions from your starting point. The street address of the Grand Hyatt Denver is: 1750 Welton Street, Denver, Colorado 80202; Tel: 303-295-1234. See below for directions from the airport and general directions from other areas.

From Denver International Airport (40 minutes/23 miles):

Exit Pena Blvd. to I-70 West. Proceed to I-25 South. Exit at Speer Blvd.

South and proceed on Speer Blvd. Turn left on Lawrence St. Turn right on 17th St. Turn left on Welton, we are located on the right.

From Points West:

Take I-70 West to I-25 South. Follow I-25 South to Speer Blvd. South (To Downtown). Speer Blvd. to Lawrence St., turn left. Follow Lawrence St. to 17th St., turn right. Follow 17th St to Welton St., turn left. Hotel is on the right.

From Points East:

Take I-70 East to I-25 South. Follow I-25 South to Speer Blvd. South (To Downtown). Speer Blvd. to Lawrence St., turn left. Follow Lawrence St. to 17th St., turn right. Follow 17th St to Welton St., turn left. Hotel is on the right.

From Points North:

Follow I-25 South to Speer Blvd. South (To Downtown). Speer Blvd. to Lawrence St., turn left. Follow Lawrence St. to 17th St., turn right. Follow 17th St to Welton St., turn left. Hotel is on the right.

From Points South:

Follow I-25 North to Speer Blvd. South (To Downtown). Speer Blvd. to Lawrence St., turn left. Follow Lawrence St. to 17th St., turn right. Follow 17th St to Welton St., turn left. Hotel is on the right.

Hotel Parking:

The Hyatt offers Valet Parking in a covered garage. Overnight Parking is available seven days/week for \$26/night, includes in and out privileges. Daily parking is available seven days/week: 0 - 3 hours: \$10; 3 - 10 hours: \$16; 10 + hours: \$26. Oversized vehicle parking is available seven days/week for \$35/day For guests with oversized vehicles, please note, the limited height clearance of our garage (6'9"). If you prefer, self-parking is available at several parking lots close to the hotel.

**Getting Around Denver**

Denver offers several modes of transportation for getting around the area.

- **16<sup>th</sup> Street Shuttle** – Runs throughout the central business and entertainment district of downtown Denver
- **Light Rail Service/RTD** – Stops at most corners in the city, including Invesco Field, Pepsi Center/Six Flags/Elitch Gardens, Union Station - Lower downtown (LODO)/Coors Field/16th Street Mall.
- **Amtrak** – Union Station is approximately 11 blocks from the hotel.

**Transportation to Union Station:**

Union Station is accessible via:

- 16th St Shuttle - Shuttle stops 1 block from Grand Hyatt Denver. The hotel does not provide transportation to Union Station
