Traveling From O'Hare:

Shuttles depart from O'Hare airport every 10-15 minutes for downtown service to Chicago hotels, downtown businesses, near north residential locations, and suburban locations. The loading zones for boarding the Airport Express van are at **Door 1E, Door 2D, and Door 3E** across from baggage claim on the Baggage Claim level. **At the international terminal we are located just outside Door 1E**, which is just outside of baggage claim and Customs. The last Airport Express van leaves O'Hare at 11:30 pm seven nights a week. Airport Express Ticket Counters for purchasing tickets are located at Door 1E, Door 2D, and Door 3F lower level across from baggage claim on the Baggage Claim level. **Reservations are not required to downtown Chicago.**

Traveling From Midway:

Shuttles depart from Midway airport every 15 minutes for downtown service to Chicago hotels, downtown businesses and near north residential locations. The airport express ticket counter and loading zone is located at Door 3, lower level across from baggage claim. Reservations from Midway to downtown are not necessary. The last Airport Express van leaves Midway at 10:30 pm seven nights a week. **The Airport Express Counter is located at Door 3, Lower Level. Reservations are not required to downtown Chicago.**

TAXIS

From O'Hare Airport to Downtown Chicago:

Taxicabs are available on a first come, first serve basis from the lower level curbside of all terminals. Shared ride service is available. There are no flat rates because all taxicabs run on meters. Expect to spend approximately \$35 to \$40 for a taxicab ride to downtown Chicago. More than 20 taxi companies in Chicago currently operate wheelchair accessible minivans equipped with ramps, wheelchair securements and shoulder seat belts. To order an accessible taxi, call the centralized dispatch service toll-free at 800-281-4466.

From Midway Airport to Downtown Chicago:

Taxicabs are available on a first-come, first-serve basis from the lower level curbside of the terminal. Shared ride service is available. There are no flat rates because all taxicabs run on meters. Expect to spend approximately \$25 to \$28 for a taxicab ride to downtown Chicago. More than 20 taxi companies in Chicago currently operate wheelchair accessible minivans equipped with ramps, wheelchair securements and shoulder seat belts. To order an accessible taxi, call the centralized dispatch service toll-free at 800-281-4466.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Chicago Transit Authority serves both O'Hare and Midway Airports. The Blue Line serves O'Hare and the Orange Line serves Midway. For schedule and fare information, see www.transitchicago.com.

RENTAL CARS

At O'Hare Airport:

Rental car agencies are located on the lower level near the baggage claim areas of Terminals 1, 2, and 3. Look for signs and courtesy phones. From Terminal 5, rental car agencies are available by courtesy telephones located on the lower level. Many rental car agencies also offer courtesy buses to various automobile pick-up/drop-off areas. During the FACE construction project, please look for signs which may indicate a temporary relocation of the rental car areas or courtesy phones.

At Midway Airport:

Rental car agencies are located inside the terminal, Lower Level Arrivals. Rental car pick-up and drop-off points are located on Level 2 of the Midway Airport Parking Garage.

**OTHER TRANSPORTATION****Greyhound Bus Lines**

The Bus Station is 1.6 miles west of the Renaissance Chicago Hotel at 630 W. Harrison St., Phone: 312-408-5821. For schedule and fare information, see [www.greyhound.com](http://www.greyhound.com).

**Amtrak**

**Chicago Transit Authority Subway**

The State & Lake subway station is .1 mile south of the Renaissance Chicago Hotel on State Street. It is not wheelchair accessible. The Lake subway station is .2 miles south of the Renaissance Chicago Hotel on State Street and is wheelchair accessible. See [www.transitchicago.com](http://www.transitchicago.com) for route maps and schedules. CTA runs buses and elevated/subway trains serving the city and 40 nearby suburbs. All buses on the 154 CTA routes are equipped with lifts or ramps and securement systems. They also have an audio/visual system that uses GPS technology to automatically announce each upcoming bus stop, both audibly and on a visual display. On the rail system, most train cars have accessible doors and each train has a minimum of two accessible cars. At present 72 rail stations have elevators or ramps with additional stations being renovated on the Brown and Red lines. A list of accessible stations and those equipped with TTY phones appears on the back of the CTA Bus & Rail Map as well as online.

Registered paratransit riders who would like to extend their eligibility to Chicago while visiting should contact Pace Paratransit at 312-341-8000. All visitors must present documentation that they are ADA paratransit eligible for the jurisdiction in which they reside. ADA paratransit certification (with expiration date) and a photo ID should be faxed to 312-341-8050. Allow at least 1-2 weeks for processing. Pace will then issue an RTA paratransit pass good for 21 days (extendable to 30 days) and provide a list of phone numbers for the various paratransit operators. Once certified, visitors can set up arrival and departure paratransit rides, if desired, by calling 312-341-8035. Certification also allows visitors to use the Taxi Access Program.

**Driving Directions:**

**From Chicago/O'Hare (ORD) to Renaissance Chicago Hotel:**

Take I-190 East to I-90 (Kennedy Expressway) East to the Ohio Street Exit. Ohio Street is a one-way street eastbound. Take Ohio to Clark, turn right. Go across the river and turn left at the first light (Wacker). Hotel is on the right at the corner of Wacker and State.

**From Chicago/Midway (MDW) to Renaissance Chicago Hotel:**

Go North on Cicero Ave. to I-55 North. I-55 North to Lake Shore Drive. Continue in right hand lane to Randolph St. Exit on Randolph St. Underpass West to Dearborn St. Turn right north on Dearborn. Continue then take a right on Wacker Drive. Hotel is on the right hand side in just past 35 West Wacker.

**Parking at the Renaissance Chicago Hotel:**

Valet parking is available for \$49/day. In/out privileges are included in valet parking fee. Large SUVs and other oversized vehicles are not allowed.
