# TRAVELLING TO AND FROM THE AIRPORT

## Public Transportation



The conference hotel, **Hyatt Regency Denver**, is accessible via the ["A Line"](#) which runs to and from the airport and Denver's **Union Station**.

Trains leave every:

- 15 min (6 a.m. - 8 p.m.)
- 30 min (early a.m., late p.m.)

The 23-mile trip takes 37 minutes.

## FIND THE A LINE AIRPORT STATION

◆ Take the escalators up to the Jeppesen Terminal

◆ Make a right

◆ Keep walking until you see signs directing you to the escalator for the A Train

◆ The A Train is the only line running to and from the airport, so you can get on whatever train is on the platform and get off at the final stop (Union Station)

◆ Tickets are available from kiosks on the platform

## MALL RIDE: BUS TO CONFERENCE HOTEL

◆ Walk South until you reach 17th and Blake

◆ Take the Mall Ride to 15th and California

Once you arrive at Union Station, you can **EITHER**:

• Walk to the Hyatt Regency Denver (15-20 min.)

**OR**

• Take the free electric bus, the "Mall Ride"

## Car Services

Taxis and ride share services are also available from the Denver Airport.

**Denver International Airport is approximately 25 miles from the conference venue.** The freeway connecting the airport and downtown Denver is a primary traffic artery.

◆ Transportation times can vary greatly--ranging from 35 minutes in the best case, to far longer in many other instances

◆ Taking public transit is thus the most dependable (and environmentally friendly!) choice
